### I.

**Though our call is to GO outward, many are content to stay inward.**

For years, many have defined ministry as activities done only in a church setting.

Unless you had a church title, you were not considered a minister.

Remaining confined inside a building for worship, posed a challenge for the historical church, and still does for us today.

### II.

**We are commanded to GO into every person's world.**

The English word "world" is translated "kosmos" in the Greek.

Kosmos speaks to any ordered system found in society:

Arts & Entertainment, Business, Congregation, Direct Media, Education, Family, and Government.

In Scripture, satan is described as the god of this world (kosmos or systems) *2 Corinthians 4:4*

### III.

**We are commanded to preach the Gospel in every person's world.**
