

Justice How is Your Serve?

I SERVING

Matthew 25 ³⁴⁻³⁶ “Then the King will say to those on his right, ‘Enter, you who are blessed by my Father! **Take what’s coming to you in this kingdom.** It’s been ready for you since the world’s foundation. And here’s why: I was hungry and you fed me, I was thirsty and you gave me a drink, I was homeless and you gave me a room, I was shivering and you gave me clothes, I was sick and you stopped to visit, I was in prison and you came to me.

Matthew 25:31-46

In this chapter we have three parables that describe **kingdom** principles for preparation, giving an account, and the final judgment or reward.

We prepare for the final judgment by showing justice through serving.

How is your serve?

It is all about serving now and when Jesus returns! *Matthew 25:21*

When we think of the kingdom of heaven, we should consider the gospel, the external kingdom of Christ, the administration / government and, how we are serving accordingly for its success. This passage of scriptures tells us what it will be like, when the mystery of God is finished.

How is your **judgment** ... how will you be judged in the end? How are you serving justice?

II JUDGMENT

The act of judging; is the act or process of the mind in comparing its ideas, to find their agreement or disagreement, and to ascertain truth or *the process of examining facts and arguments, to ascertain*

propriety(respect) and justice; or the process of examining the relations between one proposition(intention) and another. King Jesus will be the final judge of all men as mentioned in *Matthew 25*, but until He returns **believers** must occupy or serve righteous judgment until He returns. *Luke 19:13*

We are not to judge a person’s status with God, but we have the ability to make determinations and compare the relations of facts and truths. In this form of **judgment**, we must be careful to weigh and compare all the facts connected with the truth and justice ... without prejudice, or impartiality.

It is imperative to make proper judgments and address the truth about what is happening in our communities, such as the current B.R.E.A.D. issues - infant mortality rate, the disparity in employment, the lack of adequate services for mental health assistance, a program to allow flexibility in acquiring government ID’s, restorative process in schools, and the violence in our communities. Where will you serve?

III Justice

The virtue which consists in giving to everyone what is his due; practical conformity to the laws and to principles of rectitude (righteousness) in the dealings of men with each other; honesty; integrity in commerce or mutual intercourse. *justice* is distributive or commutative.

Is there justice within the **seven mountains** of government, business, religion, families, education, arts and entertainment or the media.
