Discover v. 14

Awake -to arouse from sleep, to raise up, produce, cause to appear, to cause to bring before the public, stir up, to raise up i.e. cause to be born, construct, erect.

Arise - to cause to rise up, raise up, raise up from laying down, to raise up, cause to be born, to cause to appear, bring forward, stand up, of those who leave a place to go elsewhere, of those who prepare themselves for a journey.

II

Develop v. 14

Christ shall give - Christ will **pour** upon you the divine truth as the sun gives light to men aroused from sleep.

III

Deploy

Walk - to make one's way, progress; to make due use of opportunities, to regulate one's life, to conduct one's self

Circumspectly - exactly, accurately, diligently

Acts 10:34-38 ³⁴ Then Peter replied, “I see very clearly that God shows **no favoritism**.³⁵ In every nation he accepts those who fear him and do what is right.³⁶ This is the message of Good News for the people of Israel—that there is peace with God through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all.³⁷ You know what happened throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee, after John began preaching his message of baptism.³⁸ And you know that God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. Then Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

Walk accurately in the anointing – accept all that fear Him, teach peace through Jesus Christ and **do good**.
