

Training to Reach I

Luke 9:37-42 and *Luke 10:1-3*

NKJ Luke 9:37 Now it happened on the next day, when they had come down from the mountain, that a great multitude met Him. ³⁸ Suddenly a man from the multitude cried out, saying, "Teacher, I implore You, look on my son, for he is my only child. ³⁹ "And behold, a spirit seizes him, and he suddenly cries out; it convulses him so that he foams *at the mouth*, and it departs from him with great difficulty, bruising him. ⁴⁰ **"So I implored Your disciples to cast it out, but they could not."** ⁴¹ Then Jesus answered and said, "O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you and bear with you? Bring your son here." ⁴² And as he was still coming, the demon threw him down and convulsed *him*. Then Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, healed the child, and gave him back to his father.

NKJ Luke 10:1 After these things **the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.** ² Then He said to them, "**The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.**" ³ **"Go your way;** behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves.

Jesus was a master teacher, trainer and developer.

To teach applies to any manner of imparting information or skill so that others may learn. To teach means to cause to acquire knowledge or skill.

To train means to teach someone the skills needed to do something.

To develop means to empower someone with confidence, boldness and courage in application.

I

Consider *Luke 9:37-42*

Jesus is made aware that His disciples had lack of faith, in aspects of ministry.

Jesus demonstrates how to cast out devils. *Vs 42*

- Demonstration is to build their faith and confidence.

II

Consider *Luke 10:1-3*

Jesus then trains the disciples through participation.

Jesus sends them to thirty-five cities, that He's going to. *Vs 1*

Wherever they went, He would come.

If they didn't go, He wouldn't come.

- If we don't go He won't come.

III

Consider *Luke 10:1-3*

We must believe...

The harvest is plentiful. *Vs 2a*

That prayer will move the hand of the Lord of the harvest. *Vs 2b*

That prayer will move on the hearts of laborers and harvesters.

The harvesters and laborers will have confidence and boldness to go. *Vs 3*

- Participation is critical to training.
- Application is the goal of training.
