### I

#### Who am I?

- This is a question of identity.

Consider *1 John 3:1-2*

What is your name?

Consider *Genesis 27:18-19* and *Genesis 32:24--30*

#### Where did I come from?

- This is a question of source.

Consider *Genesis 1:26-28* and *Psalms 139:14-17*

### II

#### Why am I here?

- This is a question of purpose.

Consider *2 Timothy 1:8-9*

Everything is created with purpose

- Nothing exist without purpose
- Not every purpose is known

- Where purpose is not known, abuse is inevitable

Abuse is abnormal use of self, a product or person.

Consider *Romans 8:28*

Everything is God sent or God use when it is “Called according to His purpose.”

#### What can I do while I am here?

- This is a question of potential.

Consider *Philippians 4:13* “Through Christ”

“Christ is the anointing, the presence and the empowerment of God”

- I can do everything I am assigned, empowered and authorized to do.

- This is a question of ultimate destiny.
